Beginning in 2008, the Santa Clara Superior Court will operate its family division in three courthouses: North County (Sunnyvale), Central County (Park Center Plaza, San Jose), and South County (Morgan Hill). Effective November 1, 2007, all new filings must be accompanied by a Declaration of Residence, and new filings will be assigned to one of these three courthouses based on that Declaration. Cases assigned to North County or South County will be heard in those locations when the family departments open in those courthouses, expected in January 2008 for North County and fall 2008 for South County. The Supervising Judge of the Family Division may, upon a showing of extreme hardship to one or both parties, transfer

1 a case from one courthouse to another. Motions to transfer a case from one courthouse to
2 another shall be made in the Department of the Supervising Judge.

3 Also effective November 1, 2007, parties must complete and file a Family Law Judgment
4 Checklist or a Family Law Parentage Judgment Checklist when submitting judgments for
5 processing.

6 This order will be in effect until these matters will be addressed by changes in the family
7 division local rules expected July 1, 2008.
